Guidelines

Eligibility – Nominees for the Stan Young Migrant Education Student Scholarship Award must:

- a. be currently migrant eligible (or a student who was a current migrant when he/she entered the 9th grade), ex. If a student was migrant eligible in the 9th grade but has since run out of eligibility, they may still apply/be eligible for this scholarship.
- b. have senior status in high school at the time of the award, and
- c. have plans to attend a post secondary institution or other advanced training.

Application Process - Each applicant must submit the following by February 26th:

- a. personal information,
- b. educational data,
- c. a list of high school activities (extracurricular activities, academic achievements, community service, and student work history) for grades 9-12,
- d. my essay,
- e. at least two (2) letters of recommendation from a school or community/educational agency representative with personal knowledge of the applicant's character and commitment to pursuing further education,
- f. a copy of his/her current Migrant Certificate of Eligibility (COE),
- g. a copy of high school transcript,
- h. a copy of attendance for first semester of senior year, and

Selection Criteria – The selection will include, but not limited to, the student:

- demonstrating commitment to educational goals,
- participating in school/migrant related activities,
- participating in community and/or non-school activities,
- demonstrating good citizenship qualities,
- presenting evidence of high mobility (inter or intrastate), and
- overcoming unusual odds/need.
